







- 1. Meeting of the Board of Directors was call to order @ 10:30 by President Ken Bruckner, with the pledging to the Flag.

 - d. Board approval was given for the payment of 2 nights at the Radisson for the winner of the benevolent fundraising prize winner at the May convention in the amount of \$213.12. The winner was Jeff Miller of Rice Lake Lodge #1441.
- 5. Tyson Ray reviewed the status of the investment funds and the effects of the August market pull-back had on the fund balance.
- Ken Bruckner presented the Grand Lodge Committee on Judiciary official approval of the updated General By-Laws of the Wisconsin Elks Benevolent Fund Inc dated 08/24/2015, approval number 15-15-GBLR.
- 7. Jackie Heitmann reported on the benevolent fundraising. The Board approved up to \$100 for the winners of the pirates treasure chest coin count contest.
- 8. The Board approved the postponing of the 2 million dollars cake celebration until the fund actually reaches the 2 million dollar goal.
- 9. \$5 coin books for the local lodge were presented as a local lodge fundraiser for the benevolent fund.
- 10. A discussion to file the annual report of the utilization to the Grand Lodge funds in regards to filing as early as possible to try to receive the Grand Lodge fund earlier to assist in the payment of scholarship due in August.
- 11. PGER F Louis Sulsberger appointed David Hagen, Janesville Lodge 254 as Assistant Secretary/Treasurer and authorized him as a check signer for the checking account and to work with and assist Keith Simmons, Secretary/Treasurer in the transition to the Secretary/Treasurer position.

- Meeting called to order by Chairman Daley at 9 AM and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance by all
- 2. Roll call was taken
- 3. Moment of silence for the victims of 9/11.
- 4. PGER Sulsberger called upon to introduce special guest Ronald Hicks, GER from Virginia
- 5. Motion by Johnson, second by Derosier to approve the minutes
- 6. Daley asked for discussion regarding the raffles that only the state can run at conferences and conventions. Benevolent Fund and State Major Project would like to have raffles at each. They would like to have it carte blanch to hold them without asking. All attending agreed that they could.

- 10. Voulgaris asked about combining the mens and ladies luncheons. Johnson disagreed as 40 to 60 ladies enjoy their time together, especially the widows. Derosier noted that the ladies raise funds from raffles, etc. Behnke also commented about the widows and the luncheon. Voulgaris will leave alone. He thanked Johnson and the ladies for doing a great job with the Association Raffles.
- 11. Olander asked about Lodge Development. Behnke stated they are looking into South Milwaukee, Racine, Kenosha, West Bend and LaCrosse. New chair of the committee and things will begin to happen.



One of these is with medical prescriptions. This has been identified as a major area that leads to addiction. He talked of working with the medical field and with pharmacies to insure safe guards are in place. He also talked of looking at how those with addiction are currently being treated. Prisons don't deal with the addiction problem. All were impressed with the presentation. It was also noted th the grand exalted ruler remained for the whole presentation. 8. Brien talked about the lifetime volunteer award and encouraged lodges to find those who have contributed lots during their lifetime. They can contact Brien for information. 9. Brien spoke about the Enrique Camarena Award. Lodges are encouraged ot talk to law enforcement for possible contacts. Information needs to get to Brien by Dec. 1. 10. Lodges should look into Clean Sweep Days in their communities and encourge the community to turn in unused prescriptions.
