

SITE REPORTS - Site reports were given by those representatives in attendance. The reoccurring
Theme was again COVID as the sites have strict rues regarding entering the facilities and receiving donated
goods. The sites are using their funds for purchasing gift cards for Veterans in their area for fuel, food and clothing
tems. This has proven to be both popular and effective. Additionally, the sites work closely with the VA and other
Veterans programs to ensure he cards go to those that indeed need the assistance. This is working out very well.
All sites are looking for the time they can return to "normal" operation and continue their work in the Veteran
community.
FUND REQUESTS – With our remaining funding at roughly \$14,000, and the gift cards being so popular, we
have decided to divide the remaining funds among the sites listed below so they can continue to provide the
assistance to the Veterans. The funding allocations are as follows: Beaver Dam-\$3000, Green Bay-\$1800,
Tomah-\$3000, Chippewa Falls-\$1000, Clark county-\$700, King-\$1000, Superior-\$800, Wausau-\$500, Wisconsin
Rapids-\$500, Oshkosh-\$2000 for a total distribution of \$14,300. It was a vote unanimous to support this funding.
PRESENTATIONS- We talked about the Dogs2Dog Tags program and how it started. We have had this group at
our Lodge #299 several times for our Veterans Lunch. A number of reps were interested in this for their Lodge, and
they will contact Mike for additional info.
VERTRAN VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR-We talked about this program and how Wisconsin has not had one
since 2012! There was one name submitted this year which was forwarded on as needed. We need to get this
information out to our Lodges.

There were 9 members and 14 guests presnet. Special guests included Dave Hagen of Janesville Lodge and Todd Lindsay.

We reviewed the ENF pages at the elks.org website with special emphasis on the need for every lodge to have a registered chair. The ENF chair dashboard liniks were reviewed. Chairs were urged to regsiter early and review the educational materials throughout the year to raise their chair challenge scores. Chair challenge scores will be used in a new incetnive for the Gratitude Grant starting April 1, 2022. All but two lodges have registered chairs (by end of weekend, they both had registered chairs).

Reminders were given about Fidelity program and how the ENF national recognition programs have changed. Lance Pliml of Wisconsin Rapids suggested local recognition efforts be made.

There was discussion about using online remittance forms and the need to get donations for the end of the year in as soon as possible given potential mailing delays.

There was lengthy discussion about changes to Community Investment Program grants and how they are changing. Beacon Grant will be \$4,000 bu no decision yet on if it needs to be an active project. Gratitude Grant is \$2,000 plus \$500 for 15% of members donating luse \$500 for 5% of donors being in Fidelity Club plust \$500 for chair challenge score of 550 or above. Spotlight Grant is \$2000 with no decision yet on if it needs to be an active project. Promise Grant dropped for 2022. No info on Impact Grant yet. Freedom Grants remain in place and are competitive. Reminder to plan a project and apply April 1 if interested.


